Dear Resident:

The Village of Hillburn will be modifying our Trash Pick Up Program. Instead of two large pick-ups a year, the Village will now pick up the bulk items outlined below on every third Thursday of the month. The program will begin in December and follow the schedule below:

December 20, 2007
January 17, 2008
February 21, 2008
March 20, 2008
April 17, 2008
May 15, 2008
June 19, 2008

July 17, 2008
August 21, 2008
September 18, 2008
October 16, 2008
November 20, 2008
December 18, 2008

*Residents are requested to use their discretion in the event of a forecast of snow.

ONLY THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL BE PICKED UP AND MUST BE KEPT IN SEPARATE PILES: (I.E. METALS, BRUSH, ETC.)

1. Furniture, household appliances, large appliances (such as refrigerators with doors removed, washing machines, dryers, dishwashers and hot water tanks).
***Lawn Mowers must be drained of gasoline & oil prior to placing at curbside for pick-up.**
2. Garden, yard and lawn waste such as tree branches and brush. Branches are to be no larger than 2" in diameter. (all brush must be cut and tied into 4' sections)


THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL NOT BE PICKED UP:

Construction debris, including sheet rock, lumber, roof shingles, concrete, bricks, and tires (it is the homeowners' responsibility to see that construction debris and tires are disposed of properly). Do not place these materials at curbside at any time.

Trash is not to be placed at curbside prior to the weekend before the scheduled pick-up date

I feel this will be a more user friendly program for our residents. If residents cooperate, the Village will continue this service in future years.
