<u>DR-4480 COVID-19 Pandemic Hazard Mitigation Grant Pro. (HMGP)</u> – Application filed 6/1/2022 – Project: Purchase of 4 Standby Power Generators for 4 Village owned buildings – No further report.

<u>NYS Archives – Local Records Management Improvement Fund (LGRMIF) Grant</u> – 50% of the grant, in the amount of \$6,425.00, was received on 10/14/2022. Quotes are being obtained for a shredding service.

<u>Corona Virus State & Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) – \$100,820.01</u> - Project: "Veterans Memorial Park Pond Restoration" – Current expenditures at this date total \$3,902.75.

<u>2022 Crest Grant – Proposed Projects: Garbage Truck and Pre-Fab Garage</u> – Application filed. 12/19/22 letter from Senator Reichlin-Melnick advising that he is unable to make any further awards for grant funding, as he was not re-elected. <u>2022 Volunteer Fire Assistance Grant – Proposed Purchase: Search & Rescue Equipment</u> – \$1,500 Grant was awarded. Deadline for completion: 6/30/2025.

<u>Village Engineer's Report</u> – Engineer Mancuso reported:

-<u>Paving of Upper End of Sixth Street</u> – Specifications are being developed. Engineer Mancuso will determine who has the Town of Ramapo Bid, in the event the Village Board would rather not go out to bid.

-4th St. Curb and Sidewalk Project - CHIPS Reimbursement, in the amount of \$4,346.50, was received on 12/23/2022. Engineer Mancuso will contact MFD Quality Construction, Inc. regarding the Bond to be held for a year, thus allowing the retainage to be paid and filed for CHIPS reimbursement.

- -6th Street Culvert The surveyors have completed the topo. A small area of wetlands was identified; however the project will not be in the area. If the state requires further information, it will have to be done in the spring.
- -5th Street DPW Garage Engineer Mancuso stated the specifications for a block building are near completion. A discussion was held regarding the need for the existing block shell. DPW Supt. stated that he would like to retain it for storage. Engineer Mancuso stated that possibly the roof could be raised to match the new building.
- -<u>Veterans Memorial Park Pond Restoration</u> (5) Samples for sieve testing are being obtained from Allied Drilling. Testing will be performed by Frank Getchell of Weston & Sampson.

<u>Stormwater Consortium</u> – 1/9/2023 Email – RE: NYSDEC Stormwater Permit Requirements – 3 Year Assessment of Highway Garages, and Highway Training – Engineer Mancuso will work with DPW Supt. Conklin.

Village Attorney's Report - Village Attorney Terry Rice reported

-<u>Draft of Local Law for Amendment of Zoning Law & Comprehensive Plan</u> – Attorney Rice reported that the Village Planner, Bonnie Franson supplied responses comments contained in the RC Dept. of Planning GML Review, along with revisions to the draft local law, for review by the Village Board. The Hillburn Planning Board's review of the Draft Zoning Local Law is also pending. When received, a Public Hearing can be scheduled.

1/13/2023 Maturity of \$100,000 BAN

The following RESOLUTION was offered by Trustee McNally and seconded by Trustee Tarantino who moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Village of Hillburn solicited interest bids from three (3) banks for a \$50,000.00 BAN to renew, in part, a \$100,000.00 BAN (Various Capital Improvements); and

WHEREAS, interest bids were returnable on or before 12:00noon on January 5, 2023; and

WHEREAS, one (1) interest bid was received on 1/5/2023:

M & T Bank: \$50,000.00 1 Year Bank Qualified/Non-Taxable BAN: 6.31%

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Board of Trustees hereby rejects the bid submitted by M & T Bank as exorbitant and not in the best fiscal interest of the Village; and

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED that rather than renew the BAN in part, the Village Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the payment of the BAN in whole, along with interest, to Webster Bank, as follows:

BAN (Principle): \$100,000.00 BAN (Interest): 2,961.75 1/13/2022 Payment: \$102,961.75

FURTHER, the Village Board of Trustees hereby authorizes amendment to the 2022-2023 General Fund Budget as follows:

BAN (Various Capital Improve) A97308 - Appropriations: Increase from \$25,000 to \$100,000
