- -5th Street DPW Garage Engineer Mancuso stated the specifications are being prepared. A discussion was held regarding whether or not to keep existing block shell.
- -6th Street Culvert An analysis is being done to determine if the culvert is sufficient for the volume; as well as the logistics of maintaining traffic access during construction.
- -<u>Suffern Rd Water Main</u> A hydrologist from Brooker Engineering reported a possible leak in the water main. An inspection will be made.
- -<u>Paving of Upper End of Sixth Street</u> Specifications are being developed. Engineer Mancuso reported the Town of Ramapo has not awarded its bid as of this date.
- -<u>Veterans Memorial Park Pond Restoration</u> (5) Samples for sieve testing have been obtained from Allied Drilling. Testing will be performed by Frank Getchell of Weston & Sampson.
- -4th St. Curb and Sidewalk Project Engineer Mancuso will contact MFD Quality Construction, Inc. regarding the Bond to be held for a year, thus allowing the retainage to be paid and filed for CHIPS reimbursement.
