## -RC Dept. of Health – Lead and Copper Rule Revisions – Lead Service Line Inventory Information

DPW Supt. stated he met with Tanner Morales of RC Health Department on 5/12/2023 regarding a survey of the Village's water system. The deadline to prepare a plan regarding the Lead Service Line Inventory is October 2024.

### **DPW Report - DPW Supt. Conklin**

- -Fibar has been placed at the Youth Center & East Hillburn playground areas.
- -RC Health Dept. Food Service Establishment Inspection at Youth Center Supt. Conklin reported that the issues stated in the 5/22/23 Summary Report are being rectifed: leaks in kitchen hand wash sink; and women's bathroom sinks.
- -The water fountain at the Youth Center is also being repaired.
- -Youth Center Deck Supt. Conklin reported he is following up on covering it with astroturf.

### <u>Purchase of DPW Vehicles</u> (Proposed Funding: Bond)

- -Garbage Truck Supt. Conklin is meeting with a representative of Sanitation Equip. to obtain an estimate for a new truck.
- -Replacement of 2008 Ford F-350 (Currently Registered as Salvage following a Total Loss Settlement from Village's insurance company due to a 4/20/2022 Accident) – Supt. Conklin requested that the truck be declared surplus, to be replaced upon the purchase of a new truck. A discussion was held on methods to determine availability and estimated cost for the new truck, including an online "mini bid", or contacting various suppliers.

A MOTION was made by Trustee McNally and seconded by Mayor Tursi authorizing the DPW Supt. to obtain an estimate(s) for the purchase of a new Ford F-350, and

FURTHER, upon the purchase of a new DPW truck, the 2008 Ford F-350 is to be declared surplus – REASON: No longer needed for Municipal purposes.

## Village Attorney's Report - Village Attorney Terry Rice reported

Noved LOMR-F (Letter of Map Revision) filed on 2/7/2023 – Denied by Floodplain Administrator on 2/10/2023

An Order to Show Cause and Supporting Papers to hold Village of Hillburn (Plaintiffs) in Contempt of Court was filed by the Attorney for Nicholas Cianciaruso, NAC Maintenance, Inc., Craig Flanagan, Jr., Outdoor Properties, LLC, Douglas L. VanSchaik, William Cianciaruso a/k/a/ Bill Diamond and Diamond Truck Service, Defendants.

-Attorney Rice summarized the Defendants' motion to hold the Village in Contempt: Noved's request to remove a portion of the property from the floodplain on the basis that they elevated the area with the import of fill was denied due to the fill was placed on the property without proper permits, and has been determined to contain contaminants. Further, the respective property is the subject of court ordered remediation.

-On 6/7/2023, Attorney Rice filed papers with the Court in opposition to the motion to hold the Village in Contempt. On 6/8/2023, a Court Conference was held via zoom. The Judge's decision is pending.
