MESSAGE FROM THE MAYOR - Joseph P. Tursi

I hope you all are enjoying your spring. I would like to update you on some things happening in the village:

- -I would like to welcome Trustee Dave McNally to the Village Board.
- -We recently received a grant in the amount of seventy-five thousand dollars from State Senator Elijah Reichlin-Melnick's office. The funds will be utilized for the first phase of the rehabilitation project of Veterans Memorial Park pond. I would like to thank Senator Reichlin-Melnick for procuring the grant for the village.

The village will begin an LED lighting project in the next couple of weeks. The new lighting will be installed at the community room, firehouse and village hall. We expect to see an approximate savings of over forty percent on lighting electric costs when the project is completed in June.

- -On April 4th at the Annual Organizational Meeting, the community room was named in honor of Judy Starr. A longtime village resident, Judy served with the Ladies Auxiliary, serving over twenty years as president, and was the motivating factor in the annual Christmas Caroling tradition that distributed gifts to Hillburn seniors. Judy was also a member of the Hillburn Seniors where she also served as president. A valuable member of our community, she will be truly missed.
- -The annual Memorial Day Parade on 5/30/2022 will begin at 9:00 AM. Bike decorations are available for the kids at the village office.

<u>2022-2023 VILLAGE BUDGET – 2022 VILLAGE TAX BILLS</u>

Pursuant to the 4/12/22 Public Hearing, the Budget was adopted reflecting a tax rate of \$4.83 per \$100 valuation. An increase of 23¢ over last year's rate (\$4.60 per \$100 valuation).

The Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Hillburn, New York has received the Tax Roll and Warrant for the collection of taxes for the 2022-2023 fiscal year; and will attend at the Village Office, 31 Mountain Avenue, in said Village from June 1, 2022 until July 1, 2022 during the regular office days from nine o'clock A.M. until three thirty P.M., for the purpose of receiving such taxes. On all taxes remaining unpaid after July 1, 2022, five percent will be added for the first month and an additional one percent for each month and fraction thereof thereafter, until November 1, 2022 at which time a certificate of unpaid taxes will be transmitted by the Village to the Treasurer of the County of Rockland for the collection of delinquent Village Taxes.

VILLAGE OF HILLBURN WATER DEPARTMENT

The Village of Hillburn owns and operates the Village Distribution System and purchases water from SUEZ/Veolia Co.

August 1st Bill (Period Covered: 4/1 - 7/31) December 1st Bill (Period Covered: 8/1 - 11/30) April 1st Bill (Period Covered: 12/1 - 3/31)

East year, any unpaid water bills at May 15th are relevied, with additional fees, on the respective property owner(s)' June 1st Village Tax bill.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

<u>Unregistered Vehicles</u> – In accordance with Village Code Chapter 250 - §17-G(2)(a), storage of unregistered vehicles is prohibited in all districts. Violators are subject to fines.

<u>Property Maintenance</u> – In accordance with Village Code Article I, §184-1-A, failure to keep grass/shrubbery properly trimmed is a violation. Violators are subject to fines.

<u>Reminder to Dog Owners</u> – In accordance with Village Code Chapter 65, Section 65-5-A(4), it is prohibited to allow your dog to defecate on public property without properly removing the dog waste immediately. **BAGS OF DOG WASTE SHOULD BE DISPOSED OF PROPERLY IN <u>YOUR</u> TRASH RECEPTACLE AND ARE NOT TO BE THROWN ALONG THE SIDE OF THE ROAD!!** Violators may be subject to fines. Please take pride in our community and have respect for your neighbors by working together to keep it clean.

Street Lights - Please report any street light outages to the Village Office, as soon as possible.

<u>Household Garbage</u> - Garbage must be bagged and placed in proper receptacles. Receptacles are not to be placed at curbside any earlier than the night before the scheduled pick-up date; and <u>are to be removed from curbside the day of pick-up.</u>

2022 Bulk Trash Pick-Up Schedule

Weather permitting: Tuesday, June 21st Monday, July 18th Monday, August 15th Monday, August 15th

This schedule MUST be followed. Property owners who place trash at curbside any earlier than the weekend before the scheduled pick-up date are subject to penalties. Once the DPW has collected bulk trash from your street, you CANNOT place any additional bulk trash at curbside. Construction debris will NOT be collected and is not to be placed at curbside.
